

Pierpaolo Basile is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Computer Science, University of Bari "Aldo Moro" where he received his Ph.D. in Computer Science in 2009. He is a member of the Semantic Web Access and Personalization Research Group at the University of Bari and a board member of the Italian Association for Computational Linguistics.
