

Marco de Gemmis is associate professor at the Computer Science Department, University of Bari Aldo Moro, where he received the Ph.D. degree in Computer Science in 2005. He authored over 200 scientific papers published in international journals and collections, proceedings of international conferences and workshops, and book chapters. His primary research interests include content-based recommender systems, natural language processing, information retrieval, text mining, and in general personalized information filtering. He was a program committee member for international conferences, including the ACM Recommender Systems and the User Modeling, Adaptation and Personalization (UMAP), and organized more than 15 workshops and events on these topics.

He was a Marie Curie Fellow of the SEO-DWARF Project, funded by the European Union's Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation Programme under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Grant.

He was scientific responsible for one European project and two regional projects.

He was invited speaker at several universities, including the University of Roma 3, the University of the Basque Country, San Sebastián, the University of Cagliari, the University of Milano-Bicocca, the University of Naples Federico II.

He was keynote speaker at the Workshop on Semantics-Enabled Recommender Systems at ICDM 2016 and at the ACM Summer School on Recommender Systems (2017, 2019).

He is the coordinator of the Master in Data Science (2019-2020) at the University of Bari.
